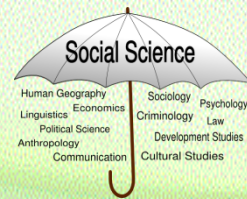

RESEARCH PROPOSAL WRITING FOR THE SOCIAL SCIENCES

This seminar is on how to develop a research proposal for fields of social science study. The issues covered in this seminar will include the selection of a topic, identifying/locating a field/discipline of study, statement of the problem, methodology, data collection and analysis, theoretical/conceptual framework, and the presentation of findings. Students will also learn how all of these elements relate back to the literature review and conclusion of a study.
