

## BRIEF BIODATA



S M Nurul Amin was awarded Doctor of Philosophy in 2008 by Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM), Selangor, Malaysia. His current position is an Associate Professor with Department of Aquaculture, Faculty of Agriculture, UPM. Also he has been selected as Guest Editor of Journal of Environmental Biology for special issue for 2020.

He was engaged with UPM as a Postdoctoral Researcher for two years (2009 - 2011) and Senior Lecturer for five years (2011 - 2015). He has 20 years of teaching and research experience in Fisheries and Aquaculture (Fisheries Biology, Population Dynamics, Stock Assessment and Aquaculture Production). By this time, a total of 34 students (28 MS and 6 PhD) were graduated under his supervision. Consequently, he has been involved in conducting 32 research projects and five consultancy projects funded by different national and international organizations (1998-2019). Throughout his career, he has won several international and national awards for his innovative research and excellent teaching contributions. Simultaneously, he has published 174 articles in peer-reviewed journals and six (6) books. His current h-index is 16 in Google Scholar and 11 in SCOPUS.
